An Act for the more full and complete establishment of a public seat of Learning in this State

And whereas it is the duty of the Legislature to provide for the education of the youth of this State... it is the duty of the Legislature to provide for the education of the youth of this State...

Therefore the Representatives of the Freemen of the State of Georgia in general Assembly do hereby enact that the same be and the same are hereby enacted...

Enacted, Enacted and Declared.

The annual expenditure necessary for the support of this State and in particular of the public seat of Learning, shall be committed and entrusted to the Governor & Council, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President of the Board of Visitors...

All Estates, lands and tenements, both of the University, shall be made, and in a case of the two Boards, either as a majority of them, subject always to be laid before the General Assembly...

The appointment of persons to be the Professors and heads of the University is one of the first and most important concerns in which its respect and usefulness greatly depend, the Board of Trustees shall first examine and nominate...

Prohibited

The Trustees shall have the power, appointing up all Vacancies of their own Board, and appointing Professors, Lecturers, Secretaries, Treasurers, Surgeons, or any other Officers which they may think necessary... The Trustees shall also have the power of nominating from Office for their own Board...
